



2016 – BASIC ESSENTIAL EDUCATION INFO

Basic Essential Education Resource Levy

All students are charged a 'Basic Essential Education Resource Levy'. This levy includes items that we are not specifically funded for by the Government eg; ID card, Locker Provision, Start-up internet & Printing Credits, Class sets of books for elective subjects (eg PE, Art, Food Tech, Community etc.) regular photocopying of worksheets & assignments, major curriculum resources, mapping tools, building works, furniture and maintenance, science labs & chemicals, cleaning products, first aid supplies & staffing, annual school magazine, additional IT and Wi-Fi support, Compass Portal subscription and support, Timetable and reporting package, additional staffing etc. For Year 12 students, the Levy also includes online access to previous SAC's, exams etc. for all subjects through Jacaranda, this costs the school over \$50 per student with only \$30 passed on to families.

Year 7, 8, 9 & 10 Essential Education Levy is \$480

- If paid by the end of Term 1 2016, you receive an early bird discount of 10% = \$48 and only need to pay \$432

Year 11 Essential Education Levy is \$320

- If paid by the end of Term 1 2016, you receive an early bird discount of 10% = \$32 and only need to pay \$288

Year 12 Essential Education Levy is \$350

- If paid by the end of Term 1 2016, you receive an early bird discount of 10% = \$35 and only need to pay \$315

Camps, Sport and Excursion Fund (CSEF)

Parents who hold a current Centrelink Card, and who have students under the age of 17 are eligible to claim the CSEF payment. Forms will be put on Compass during Term 2. Forms will need to be completed and returned to the office with a photocopy of your valid Centrelink card.

The payment of \$225, comes to the school in Term 3 and will go on your school account. It will be allocated to Camps, Excursions/Incursions, Sporting activities or the Sports Academy Levy. More details will be distributed in Term 2, 2016.

Sports Academy Levy

All students (new and existing) who have been selected to participate in the 2016 Sports Academy Program are required to pay the Sport Academy Levy **in full PRIOR to 11th of December 2015.**

NEW enrolments into Year 7 - 12 Sports Academy Levy is \$850

- All students who are new to the Sports Academy Program are required to pay the full amount of \$850 prior to the 11th December 2015. This levy includes access to the gym and Stadium facilities, access to our Sports Science Staff and other Specialists, plus your full dress uniform, ADP uniform and Technical Training uniform.

Existing/Continuing Academy Students Sports Academy Levy is \$350

All students who have been enrolled in the Program for more than 1 year and are continuing in the Program are required to pay the full amount of \$350 prior to the 11th December 2015. This levy includes access to the gym and stadium facilities, access to our Sports Science Staff and other Specialists. School Charges

Included in the attached charge list are any Camps, Excursions or Subject levies that are confirmed for 2016. These are either compulsory events or run annually as part of the curriculum. Other incursions or excursions may be added throughout the year at an additional cost. OPTIONAL EDUCATION ITEMS - Students will only be required to pay subject levies if they choose to participate in a subject that has applicable charges; eg Food, Wood, Outdoor Ed etc.
